

Specifically, Sections 4.1.1 and 5.7 are the basis for a long-standing Communications Society policy that IEEE and ComSoc e-mail aliases not be used for electioneering. I trust that everyone will show good judgment on behalf of all our voting members. At the same time, we are encouraging the candidates to make their views known, either by directly contacting or asking their supporters to reach out to friends and colleagues in their own professional communities.

ComSoc is making a concerted effort to inform members of the upcoming elections and acquaint them with the candidates, so as to stimulate a large turn-out. *Please vote!*
