More than 300 participants from 22 countries convened at the EastWest Institute's **3rd Worldwide Cybersecurity Summit** held on 30-31 October 2012 in New Delhi, India. Among them are experts, stakeholders and decision-makers from industry, government and academia, with the common goal to advance international policy to promote the security, stability and safety of cyberspace.
